She was born in Seoul, South Korea. When she was four years old, her family first immigrated to Chicago and then later moved to Orland Park, IL, where she spent most of her childhood. There she attended Carl Sandburg High School. After graduating, she entered University of Illinois at Chicago and received a degree of Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD).

Jacqui was a loving daughter and sister. Her love and care for those near and close to her heart always came before herself. While continuously striving for excellence as a student, she always made time for family. Jacqui made time to help with the family business and took care of her younger siblings. No matter how tired she may have been, when her younger sister or parents needed her assistance, she was there. Whether her parents needed her for translations or sister needed a ride, she always accommodated.

Jacqui was a truly compassionate and giving person who touched the lives of others with a beautiful heart. Her spirit filled many people with the incredible joy that came with knowing her. Her passion was her family, but she treated her friends like family as well. Jacqui loved get-togethers, traveling and trying out new experiences, such as eating an exotic dish or bungee jumping in New Zealand.
