James Freier Gervais, 74, of Olathe KS, formerly of Chicago IL, passed away peacefully on June 8, 2019. He was born on August 14, 1944 to Joseph F. and Dorothy (nee Freier) Gervais Sr., in Chicago IL.

Jim served our country in the United States Army during 1965-1967 where he was stationed in Germany.
