Amanda Miller, 39, of Urbana, formerly of Mundelein, passed away Sunday, May 5, 2024, near Gibson City as the result of a motorcycle accident.

A 2003 graduate of Mundelein High School, she was blessed with a lovely singing voice and was an inaugural member of the Mundelein Lights ladies show choir.

Amanda graduated from Eastern Illinois University in Charleston with a degree in history. She moved to Champaign and worked at Volition and EP Technologies before landing her dream job at Frasca International. She shared a love of aviation history with her father and enjoyed being a part of the aeronautics industry.

An avid motorcyclist, Amanda would take every opportunity to ride her Victory Hammer to destinations near and far, meeting old friends and making new ones. She completed the Iron Butt challenge (1,000 miles in 24 hours) in 2018 and spent many happy hours riding the Tail of the Dragon at Maggie Valley. From an early age, Amanda shared a unique bond with animals, from cats and dogs to birds and turtles. Pets and wildlife alike seemed to trust and communicate with her on a special level.

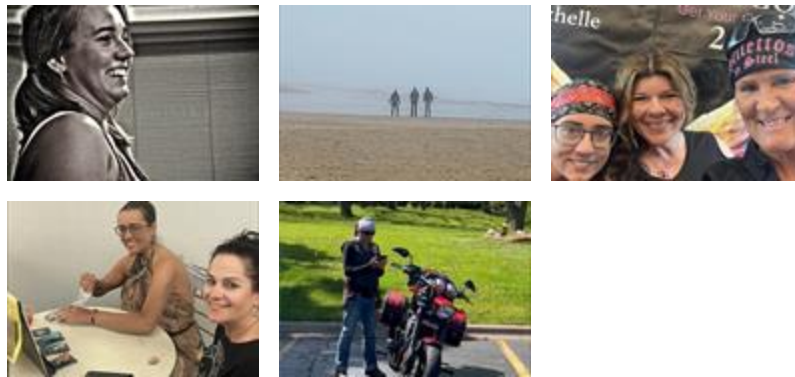
