Ann Schein (nee Moore) RN., BA., MSE., ES. 82 years old, died after a brief illness on Mon. Feb. 5, 2018 at Lake Forest Hospital. Beloved wife of 58 years to Egon Schein; loving mother of Beth (Kris Hasemann) and Juli, and devoted caregiver to Casey (feline) Schein.

She was preceded in death by her brother Gene E. Moore and her parents, Evelyn (nee Zwiger) and Edward F. Moore.

Ann had a lifelong career in health service, beginning at Swedish-American Hospital school of nursing in Rockford, IL., staff nursing in ophthalmology at Illinois Eye and Ear Infirmary, Star Hospice and RN consultant at Catholic Charities, both in Waukegan, patient representative and hospice program specialist and other various positions at Lake Forest Hospital for 20 + years.
