Arlene M. Herman, 89, passed away peacefully at her home in Libertyville on Thursday, May 7, 2026. She was born on July 31, 1936, in Chicago and was raised in Evergreen Park, IL.

Arlene met and married the love of her life, Paul Herman, and together they began their new life in Denver. After a few short years they moved to Michigan, where Arlene was a devoted and active member of Midland Reformed Church. There Arlene played the organ and piano, sang in the choir, and directed a youth choir known as The Jubilations. She and Paul sponsored the youth group.
