Arthur G. Buehler, 85 passed away Thursday, February 6, 2014 at Advocate Sherman Hospital in Elgin, IL. He was born April 3, 1928 in Chicago Heights, IL, was a former 50 year resident of Northbrook, living at Heather Ridge in Gurnee since 2004. He was a tireless volunteer for SHORE Community Services in Skokie, serving as president of the executive board for many years and helping to manage The Second Time Around resale shop. He was honored by the Pioneer Press Newspaper as an Outstanding Volunteer of the year and was also a SHORE Volunteer of the Year.
