



## Attilio A. Foresta

August 2, 1924 - June 21, 2018

Attilio "Al" Foresta, 93, passed away Thursday, June 21, 2018 at Advocate Condell Medical Center in Libertyville. He was born August 2, 1924 in Chicago, formerly living in Ft. Sheridan, moving to Libertyville in 1962. He was a US Army veteran entering the Aircorp in 1943 and retiring in 1966.
