April 19, 1926 - October 9, 2018

Beverly Jane Schar, nee Sabella, passed away on Tuesday, October 9, 2018 in Buffalo Grove, IL. She was born April 19, 1926 in Chicago, attended Glen Flora Grade School in Waukegan and was a 1943 graduate of LTHS. She worked for 20 years at the Cook Memorial Library in Libertyville, served on the Altar Guild of St. Lawrence Episcopal Church, and on the board of the Libertyville-Mundelein Historical Society where she brought her lifelong love of design. A humble artist— in pencil, watercolor and oils—she created beauty wherever she went and spent many Decembers decorating the Cook House for the Holidays. She was honored to be in the Libertyville Senior Hall of Fame, as the village held a special place in her heart.

Surviving are her 3 daughters, Theresa Zumwalt, Patricia (Robert) Bartholomew, and Susan Schar Duffin and by 4 grandchildren, Todd and Tenley Zumwalt, Conor (Danielle) and Kirstin Duffin.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Kenneth L. Schar in 2016, by her parents, Lawrence T. and Bertha E. (nee Anderson) Sabella and by her infant brother William Alexander Sabella.
