Calvin F. Gwynne, 91, passed away on Friday, August 17, 2018 at his home at Spring Meadows in Libertyville, IL. He was born March 30, 1927 in Chicago, IL, was a Lake County resident for over 60 years, living in Libertyville since 1960. He was a former member and Elder at Calvary Presbyterian Church in Round Lake and First Presbyterian Church in Libertyville. Cal was a US Army veteran, having served from 1945 in the occupation of Japan and from 1950-51 as a Master Sergeant in Korea and was a member of the Libertyville VFW Post #8741. He served on the Oak Grove School Board from 1970-76 and was the Scout Master for Troop #194 for 4 years at Oak Grove School. He and his wife would show and train German Shepherd Dogs from 1947-82, was a former Staff Manager of IL Bell, a member of the Telephone Pioneers of America and an official for IL for IHSA.

Surviving is his son, Andrew (Anne) Gwynne; 4 grandchildren, Justin, Clinton, Pamela (Brandon) & Ashley and a great granddaughter, Sarah.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Pearl in 2008, by son, Donald in 2013, his parents, John & Mary Gwynne and by brothers, John (Leta) Gwynne and Arthur (Anne) Gwynne.
