Charles P. Herrick, 94, passed away on Monday, Sept. 30, 2013 in Woodstock, IL. He was born Oct. 26, 1918 in Half Day, IL, the son of the late William and Pansy (Gerbert) Herrick. He lived in Half Day for 78 years until retiring to Lecanto, FL for 13 years. He was a US Navy veteran, serving in the Pacific Theatre during WWII and was a member of the American Legion and VFW. He was also a member of the Long Grove Community Church, the Wheeling Masonic Lodge and the Medinah Shrine in Chicago. Chuck was the owner of Herrick's True Value Hardware in Half Day and in 1941 joined the Vernon Fire Protection District later serving as a trustee.
