Connor A. Robinson, 18, passed away on Monday, Oct. 27, 2014 from injuries sustained in an automobile accident near Calamus, Iowa. He was born Aug. 16, 1996 in Pleasanton, CA. lived in Libertyville for 14 years and was a 2014 graduate of LHS. Known for his academic interests, Connor served on the executive board of the Model United Nations Club and was an Illinois State Scholar. He was elected by the American Legion Post #329 to represent the high school at Illinois Boys State, participated in the Science Olympiad and the Latin Club Certamen competition at Libertyville High. Connor attended Holy Cross Lutheran Church and had been an employee of Sunset Foods in Libertyville.

He was attending Cornell College in Mt. Vernon, Iowa on an academic scholarship, was involved with the Performing Arts and Activities Council and was studying diplomacy and world affairs.

Surviving are his parents, Andy and Lisa Robinson of Oceanside, CA; his brother Dylan, attending Iowa State University, sister Chelsea, attending San Diego State University and his grandmother, Joan Travis of Okemos, MI. He was preceded in death by his grandparents, Donald Robinson and Robert and Anne Lemmen.
