September 3, 1925 - February 14, 2015

Daniel Dejanovich, 89, passed away on Sat. Feb. 14, 2015 in Chicago. He was born Sept. 3, 1925 in Chicago, was a former 40 year resident of Libertyville and has lived in Barrington Hills for the past 5 years. He was a graduate of Bowen HS in Chicago and received his degree in mechanical engineering from the University of Illinois. He served in the US Army Air Corps in Italy and Africa during WWII and was a member of the American Legion. Dan was a pitcher for his baseball team in high school and a member of the city league team the Sun Dodgers, who became city champions. Following the war, he was drafted by the Chicago Cubs and played minor league ball for several years. He was employed as a mechanical engineer for ComEd for 40 years, was granted two patents and retired in 1991. Surviving are 4 children, Dara (Ken) Valin of Barrington Hills, Dana (George) Maragos of Chicago, Daniel Dejanovich, Jr. of Libertyville and David (Amy) Dejanovich of St. Charles. 4 grandchildren, Alexander, Samuel, David Hayden, Danielle and his sisters, Sophie Voich and Helen Popovich. He was preceded in death by his wife Dorothy in 1999, by his sister Angela Channic and half sisters, Marian Weeks and Ann Wagoner.
