



## Dorothy "Dottie" Watson

November 29, 1932 - August 30, 2018

Dorothy Ann "Dottie" Watson, 85, of Mundelein, passed away on Thursday, Aug. 30, 2018 in Lincolnshire. She was born Nov. 29, 1932 in Cairo, IL and was a graduate of Hyde Park HS in Chicago and the McCormick Business College. She was a former private secretary and supervisor for the Dept. of the Army in Chicago, a former member of the Fourth Presbyterian Church in Chicago and a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Libertyville. Dottie and her husband Trig loved to sing and were former members of the choir at their church in Libertyville, the Liberty Fremont Concert Society and the Apollo Musical Club in Chicago, often accompanied by the Chicago Symphony Orchestra. She was a model during her early years, was a Sunday School Teacher, assistant curator of the Great Lakes Naval Museum, president of the Libertyville Presbyterian Seniors and president of the Fort Hill Heritage Museum in Mundelein.

Surviving are her nephews, Randy and Terry Reasons and many, many friends. She was preceded in death by her husband Leland "Trig" Watson in 2003.
