



E. Arthur Stunard

January 11, 1937 - December 1, 2023

Arthur Stunard passed away on December 1, 2023 at home with family by his side. He had been dealing with Parkinsons Disease for many years. Arthur earned his B.S. and M.S. degrees from Northern Illinois University and his Ed.D. from Loyola University. He taught industrial Arts at the elementary, High school, and college levels and developed special programs for the New Jersey Department of Education to bring the workshop to the classroom. At National College of Education, later National-Louis University, Dr. Stunard developed the media program and built the television studio. He was the Director of Learning Resources and Graduate Program director, Assistant Vice President for Academic Affairs and Chicago Campus Director, and Vice President of Administration prior to serving as President of DeVry Chicago. He was asked to participate on many state and national committees and served as president of many educational organizations including the Board of the International Academic Decathlon. Arthur produced 8 films and wrote several books and multiple articles for publication. He was a good communicator who took time to listen and assist others. Music, including opera, woodworking and Habitat for Humanity, fishing, skiing and other outdoor adventures were of interest to him. He was a renaissance man who truly cared about others. Survivors include his wife Sonja-Lou Stunard; 2 children, Jason Stunard and Justin (Allison) Stunard; Granddaughter Olivia Lou; niece Laura Kutill, nephews James Rogel, Donald Rogel, and Walter Stunard as well as many great nieces and nephews.
