Frank N. Popp, 90, passed away on Friday, Aug. 22, 2014 at Advocate Condell Medical Center in Libertyville. He was born Jan. 12, 1924 in Chicago and was a warm and gracious man who always had a story to share. Frank was a master watchmaker and his jewelry store, Schierer and Popp Jewelers, which opened in 1955, continues in operation today at its original location on the northwest side of Chicago. He graduated at the top of his class from the Elgin Watch College after World War II, where he served as a sergeant with the 793rd Battalion Military Police. For the past 14 years he was a resident of Saddlebrook Farms in Grayslake, IL and was an active member of the Gallop Court Gang. He was a member of the Portage Park Chamber of Commerce and The American Aid Society of German Descendants. He loved golf, the Chicago White Sox and the Bears. He was preceded in death by his beloved wife Mary in 2011 and by his brother Richard in 2110. He is survived by his son Fred (Pam) Popp of Long Beach, IN and his daughter Mary Ellyn (David) Mason of Libertyville. Grandsons, Jonathan Mason of Dallas, TX and Michael Mason of Libertyville.
