Frederick “Fred” Charles Lutter Jr., 68, passed away on March 13, 2025 in Libertyville, IL. He was born March 21, 1956 in Brookhaven, MS and was a Mundelein, IL resident for most of his life. Fred was a graduate of Adlai E. Stevenson High School in Lincolnshire, IL and Roosevelt University in Chicago, IL. 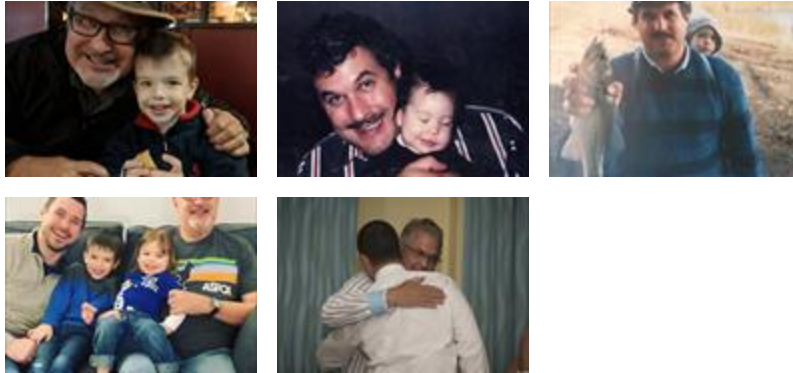
