Gail B. Manz, 80, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, Nov. 17, 2015 at Journeycare hospice in Glenview, IL surrounded by her husband of 58 years, James G. Manz and her brother Kent Beauchamp of Iron River, MI. Gail was born July 13, 1935 in Waukegan, the daughter of the late Clifford and Frances (Rae) Beauchamp. In 1958, Gail and Jim were married and made their home in Lake Forest. Gail was known as a busy, hardworking person. After graduating from Warren Twp. High School in Gurnee, she pursued a nursing career as a nurse and physicians assistant to Dr. David Kweder in Waukegan, assisting in office nursing and hospital surgeries. In 1958, Gail became Secretary to the Director of personnel at Kleinschmidt Laboratories in Deerfield, where she also became a sten-o-type operator. In 1984, Gail resigned and became quite active in the Lake Forest Women's Club and the Lake Forest Symphony Guild. Following the sudden passing of her father, Gail joined her brother in managing the family business in Waukegan, Beauchamp's Auto Radiator and Glass Service. In 1972, Gail and Jim moved to the house of their dreams at Countryside Lake. Gail participated with Jim in their antique automobile hobby, which allowed them to meet and enjoy many fellow hobbyists across the country. Gail served as treasurer, board member and 7 years as President of the Countryside Lake Association. Visitation will be from 4 to 8 pm Friday, Nov. 20 at the Burnett-Dane Funeral Home, 120 W. Park Ave. (Rt. 176, one block west of Milwaukee Ave.) Libertyville. A funeral service will be at Christ Episcopal Church, 410 Grand Avenue, Waukegan,
