



## George V. Foster

December 14, 1932 - February 28, 2025

George Vanderkolk Foster, 92, passed away on Friday, Feb. 28, 2025 in Libertyville, IL. He was born Dec. 14, 1932 in Lafayette, IN and had been a Libertyville resident since 1979. He received his undergraduate degree and Ph.D. from Purdue University and was an avid Purdue men's basketball fan. George had been employed by Abbott Laboratories for many years and was a US Army veteran. In the mid-1950's, he was stationed on Governor's Island while playing with the Army Band and once performed for both General Douglas MacArthur and the Queen of England. In 1991, he co-founded the Illinois Brass Band (IBB), which won an unprecedented string of six U.S. championships in seven years (1996- 2002). IBB was also honored to attend the 2003 British Open Brass Band Championships - the first brass band outside the British Commonwealth to compete in this prestigious event. George was a member of Hope Evangelical Presbyterian Church in Grayslake and an enthusiastic Cubs fan who greatly enjoyed annual trips to spring training in Arizona.

Surviving are two children, Mark Foster (Alyssa O'Neill) and Tamara Foster; three grandchildren, Samantha Foster (Montana Stahl), and Lukas and Noah Harding; a great grandchild, Fenris Stahl; and his brother, Herbert (Sandra) Foster.

He was preceded in death by his wife Charlene Foster in 2013.

A visitation will begin at 10 am Friday, March 7, 2025 until time of his funeral service at 11:30 am Friday at the Burnett-Dane Funeral Home, 120 W. One morning I got a call from George (who I didn't know at the time) inviting me to come to the first rehearsal of a new British Style Brass Band that was forming in Libertyville. At the time I was only playing trumpet in one orchestra and felt like I needed another place to play so I agreed to come out and see what it was about. The first rehearsal was a bit rough, but I could tell that this would be a lot of playing, and might do me some good, so I joined.

Fast forward a few years, and the band was going strong, and with a new music director at the helm, we became a competition winning band. The new director brought with him a few good players, one of whom was a young woman cornetist who really knew the brass band style, who after auditions, became my stand partner. A few years later, she not only was my stand partner and friend, she became my wife. We still play (in California) in brass bands as well as orchestras and Broadway shows, together.

If it weren't for George Foster, I don't think I'd have had quite the wonderful life I've had since his call.
