Glenn R. Scherrer, 73, passed away Friday, March 8, 2024 in Libertyville, IL. He was born October 22, 1950 in Chicago where he was a 1967 graduate of Steinmetz High School. He was a former resident of Deerfield and had been living in Libertyville since 1988. Glenn graduated from the University of Illinois College of Medicine at Chicago in 1973, with a BS in pharmacy, and was employed as a pharmacist for over thirty five years at Lake Forest Hospital, retiring in 2017. Glenn also worked part time at the Midwest Regional Cancer Treatment Center in Zion, now called City of Hope. He enjoyed golfing, traveling to Door County, WI and spending time outdoors, especially with his family.

He is survived by his wife of 47 years, Patty Scherrer; three children, Karen (Paul) Stille, Tim (Amelia Miller) Scherrer, Glenn (Amanda Morgan) Scherrer; two grandchildren, Dean, Lydia; two brothers, Donald (Lenore) Scherrer, Gerald (Ermalynn) Scherrer; sister, Nancy (Danny) Dahlberg; and many nieces & nephews.

I have so much history with Glenn that it has taken me sometime to process this tremendous relationship I had with Glenn.

Glenn's Mom Gertrude was best friends with my Mom Linnea Chow and we grew up together in the Austin neighborhood. We regularly attended Zion Evangelical Free Church. Later, Glenn and I served at Grace Evangelical Free Church as Awana Leaders, youth groups and of course athletic events. We played on basketball, bowling teams and anything athletic.

Glenn was a natural and extremely gifted. Some people are excellent in academics others are gifted athletically. Glenn was exceptional at both...UNIQUE.

Glenn taught me golf, and he was very patient with me when I was learning. Dan Pikel was correct I do remember our golf outings, basketball leagues and canoeing 60 miles in Superior/ Canada National Forest/ Boundary waters for 2 weeks.

An example of Glenn's natural abilities displayed when I took him skiing for the first time and was teaching the beginners 'snow plow' technique. As we went up ski lift and exited, Glenn comes paralleling down the slope like an Olympic skier like he had been skiing for years.

In August of 1974, Glenn and I took a two week trip out west. We weaved our way thru South Dakota observed Mt. Rushmore, camped and proceeded through the Bad Lands, Wyoming and finally Colorado. Camping in Rocky Mountain National Park was awesome. We hike up Cub Lake Trail, laid out on a picnic bench at night and observed God's miraculous sky with shooting stars and

the vast Milky Way!

We then drove up Trail Ridge Road and crossed the Continental Divide on our way through The Eisenhower Tunnel, Leadville Pass to playing golf in Aspen. We found the entrance to John Denver's house and then travelled to Maroon Bells. What a grandeur site! It was then our journey through southern Colorado to the Great Sand Dunes National Park and then up to Colorado Springs. We drove up Pikes's Peak, Whoa! We then reached the summit of some 14,000 plus feet. It was 80 degrees at the base when we began and 30 degrees and snowing at the top, Glenn and I on our decent stopped and walked out on a snow pack and were throwing snow balls at each other in August.

We also visited Royal Gorge, Garden of the Gods and Black Canyon of Gunnison National Park.

Glenn was ALWAYS advanced, he was double promoted in school and graduated high school when he was sixteen. I recall he was assisting in his older brother's math work while they were attending college.

So many fond memories and this is just a small synopsis of Glenn's life. The most important aspect of his life is that he put his faith and forgiveness in Jesus and has ETERNAL life!

I believe this verse describes Glenn; Galatians 5:22-23 "BUT THE FRUIT OF THE SPRIT IS LOVE, JOY, PEACE, FORBEARANCE, KINDNESS, GOODNESS, FAITHFULLNESS, GENTLENESS AND SELF-CONTROL. AGAINST SUCH THINGS THERE IS NO LAW." Accept Jesus Christ, confess your transgressions and we can once again enjoy our fellowship with Jesus and Glenn.
