November 19, 1939 - March 18, 2014

Grace Louise Schaefer, 74, of Indian Land, SC, passed away March 18th, 2014 after a brief battle with pancreatic cancer. She lived her final days surrounded by family at Hospice & Community House in Rock Hill, SC. Born on November 19, 1939 in Columbus, OH to Gavin and Christina Reilly, Grace was the youngest of five siblings. She grew up in Missouri and received her bachelor's degree in elementary education from Missouri Valley College in 1961.
