Henry M. Wegren, 92, passed away peacefully in his sleep on Saturday, December 28, 2024. He was born December 23, 1932 in Chicago, IL, the youngest of seven children. He resided in Lake Forest since 1971. Henry was a United States Navy veteran, serving on the USS Essex, where he was a member of the Naval Electronics Corps. As a servicemember, he pursued coursework at MIT and later graduated from Northwestern University.
