Herbert M. Koehler, 93, passed away Wednesday, June 17, 2015 at Manorcare of Libertyville. He was born April 15, 1922 in Chicago and had been a Libertyville resident for the past 45 years. Herb was a 1940 graduate of Lane Tech High School in Chicago and had served in WWII as a "humpback" pilot in the US Air Corps, 10th Combat Cargo which flew missions in China-Burma-India. He was former president of the Jefferson Park Lions Club and was the owner of Koehler Optics (formerly Tele-Optics) for 60 years. Herb spent the remaining days surrounded by loving family, friends and neighbors.
