Jason Todd Wiler was born on September 29, 1971, in Kalamazoo, Michigan as the son of Dr. John and Jean Wiler. Growing up, he was a member of Scout Troop 205 achieving the rank of Eagle, swam for Portage Northern High School and enjoyed AYSO soccer. He graduated from Portage Northern H.S. in 1989 and received a degree in Forensic Chemistry from Ohio University. He went on to receive his Master of Business Administration from Lake Forest Graduate School in 2015.

After graduation, he accepted a position at Kellogg's. After 2 years, the forensic lab underwent changes and he moved to the Chicago area to accept a chemistry position at Abbott Labs. Abbott spun off to AbbVie as their pharmaceutical branch and Jason was transferred as a chemist in the new company. Recently, he was a supervisor in the quality control area of the Forensic Chemistry lab at AbbVie.

In July of 2007, Jason married Kim Gonzalez and his family of two grew to a family of five. Jason has fond memories of his boy scout camping trips, working in his garden, the art of mixology, spending time at the family lake house, and trying out new recipes for his family and friends. Jason was particularly fond of traveling with his family to beautiful and historical places.

He lost his short-term battle with Colon cancer on Wednesday, November 22,

2023.

He was preceded in death by his younger brother Jonathon Wiler.

Survivors include his wife Kim, daughters Starla Wiler, Taylor (Jake) Murrin and son Ryan Gonzalez and grandson Rowyn and granddaughter to be Isla Rose Murrin.
