Jeffery R. Peterson, 56, passed away on Tuesday Aug. 29, 2023, at his home surrounded by his loving family. He was born Sept. 15, 1966, in Blue Island, IL and has been a resident of Vernon Hills for the past 29 years. He was a graduate of Buffalo Grove High School, Purdue University and received his MBA from Loyola University Chicago.

Jeff was a devoted husband, father, and friend, coaching many of his children's sports teams and maintaining constant involvement in their activities. Throughout his life Jeff carried his contagious smile with him to the Purdue marching band, BGRA meetings, pickle ball courts, and neighborhood get-togethers. Jeff was a dedicated employee at United Airlines and a member of St. Mary of Vernon Parish.

Surviving is his wife of 32 years, Marcia Peterson, 4 children, Kelly (Mitch) Deakins, Kyle (fiancé Caitlin Shepler) Peterson, Brett Peterson and Derek Peterson; his grandson Carter Deakins and father Richard Peterson. Yesterday when I was out and about, something reminded me of him. At a parking lot, a young woman was backing her big SUV into a tight parking spot. I thought Jeff would have been proud of her (he taught all his kids how to back into their garage when they first started driving). His spirit lives on in these little memories.
