Joseph P. Bohn, 76, passed away on Saturday, April 11, 2015 at Lutheran General Hospital in Park Ridge. He was born Oct. 26, 1938 in New York City and has been a resident of Vernon Hills for the past 35 years. He was a graduate of New York University and the Chicago Kent College of Law. He was a former attorney for the Interstate Commerce Commission at the Federal Building in Chicago.

Joe was also a veteran of the US Army having served in the Vietnam War. Between his active service and the reserves, he served for 26 years. He had been a member of the VFW, was an eagle scout and was active with Boy Scout Troop #44 in Indian Creek.
