Pavlovic, Josip "Joe" 75, of Knollwood, IL, passed away on Thursday, January 22, 2015 at the Lake Forest Hospital. He was born January 31, 1939 in Brezice, Slovenia and came to live in America in 1958. He has been a resident of the Lake Forest-Lake Bluff area since 1964 and a member of the Church of St. Mary in Lake Forest. Joe was a member of Teamsters Local #301 and was a truck driver for most of his life. He was a former employee of Abbott Laboratories, later driving a school bus for the Lake Forest School District.
