Julia Ingram Snyderacker passed away on Wednesday, May 25, 2022. She was born in 1938 in Oak Park, IL and was a resident of Grayslake, IL and had previously lived in Kennett Square, PA; North Andover, MA; Evanston, IL and Chicago, IL.

She is survived by two daughters, Anne Snyderacker Shivak (Alan J.) and Rebecca Snyderacker Antonoglu (John); 3 grandchildren, Nicholas Antonoglu, Julia Antonoglu and James Shivak; and many loving family and friends.

Julie was active at the First Presbyterian Church in Libertyville, IL, where she served on the Deacon Board and coordinated the church's soup kitchen program. She also served on numerous committees at the church, was a member of P.E.O., and belonged to a local book club. She had previously been president of The Near North Juniors of The Infant Welfare Society of Chicago; and in Evanston Illinois she was a Girl Scout leader and active in the North End Mother's Club as well as the Evanston Women's Club.
