



## Julius Marks Jr.

January 30, 1931 - January 9, 2022

Julius Marks, Jr. 90, passed away on Sunday, Jan. 9, 2022 at the Sheridan of Green Oaks. He was born Jan. 30, 1931 in Berlin, WI and had been a Libertyville resident since 1972. He was the president and owner of Libertyville Lincoln and president of Classic Toyota and Kia in Waukegan. Time magazine named Julius in 1991, the Quality Dealer Award, combined with excellence of dealership and community service. He was a former Chairman of the Board of Condell Medical Center, past director of the GLMV Chamber of Commerce, former trustee of Barat College and a member of the Libertyville Rotary Club.

Julius was a member of St. Joseph Parish in Libertyville, a supporter of “Big Shoulder” Inner City Schools Program of the Archdiocese of Chicago and a director of the University of Wisconsin Alumni Foundation. He was also an Air Force veteran, having served in Hawaii during the Korean War.

Surviving is his wife of 60 years, Janet Marks; 3 children, Daniel (Marie) Marks, Sheila Marks Bondoc and Fred (Laura) Marks; 8 Grandchildren, Charlotte, Julia, Daniel, Katie, Molly, Madeline, Charles and Andrew; his twin sister, Joan (Frank) Banholder.

A private visitation for his family will be held on Friday at the Burnett-Dane Funeral Home in Libertyville. A public funeral mass will be held at 10:00 a.m.
