Former Executive Director of the McHenry County Community Action Agency, Karin Nuelle, 63, died Jan. 14, at Advocate Condell Medical Center in Libertyville, IL. She was born June 9, 1952 at Fort Bragg, NC. As a result of her military upbringing, Karin was a former resident of many places around the world including: Virginia, Norway, and Germany. She has lived in Woodstock, IL for the past 25 years. She was a 1974 graduate of Indiana University, and served for more than two decades as executive director for the Illinois Head Start Association's Community Action Agency for McHenry County. Karin was a past president of the Woodstock Rotary Club where she was very active as well as in the Woodstock community, in particular with the Christmas Clearing House program.
