Mark Bosanac, 96, of Mundelein, passed away on Wednesday, Jan. 11, 2012, at Robin's Nest Senior Living Facility in St. Charles, Ill. He was born April 30, 1915 in Argo, Ill., and lived in Yugoslavia from approximately 1921 through 1936. In his retirement, Mark continued to work at his passion - building, fixing and making improvements to his home.
