



Mark H. Fields Jr. M.D.

September 4, 1937 - August 16, 2021

Mark H. Fields, Jr. M.D. 83, passed away on Monday, Aug. 16, 2021 at Advocate Condell Medical Center in Libertyville. He was born Sept. 4, 1937 in Sioux City, Iowa and had been a Libertyville resident since 1959. He was a graduate of the University of Iowa and served as a physician in Libertyville for 45 years. Dr. Fields was a member of the United Methodist Church, the American Academy of Family Practice, the American Medical Association and was a veteran of the US Navy.

Surviving are his loving wife of 60 years, Mary Fields; 3 daughters, Patricia Fields-Perry, Catherine Fields and Helen Fields; 3 Grandchildren, Justin, Alyssa and Collin; his sister, Joanne Fields-Whitaker (David) and his brother Robert Fields.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Mark Sr. and Eugenia Fields, his son Mark Fields, III and his brothers, Phillip, Henry and Gerald.
