Mary Carter, 92, passed away on Wed. April 24, 2019 at Advocate Condell Medical Center in Libertyville. She was born Feb. 21, 1927 in Raleigh, NC, grew up in Hornell, NY and has lived in Libertyville for the past 45 years. She was a 1944 graduate of Hornell HS and the Rochester General Hospital School of Nursing. After receiving her RN, she enrolled at the University of Pennsylvania and later obtained her master's degree. She was a former Director of Nursing at the Lake County Health Department, enjoyed traveling, was a member of the P.E.O., the Town and Country Garden Club in Libertyville and was an elder at Hope Evangelical Presbyterian Church in Grayslake.
