June 29, 1961 - July 20, 2012

Mayengo Florence Nlandu, 51, passed away on Friday, July 20, 2012, at her home with her family by her side. She was born June 29, 1961, in the Congo, Democratic Republic, came to the United States in 1981 and had lived in Lake Villa for the past eight years. Florence was a senior IT manager for the Discover Card Corporation, was a founding member of the New Community Church of Chicago and attended The Chapel in Libertyville. Surviving are her son, Noah Nlandu; parents, Mukoko and Mangani Nlandu; sisters, Mary (Alfred) Mayalu, Mangani (King Mukwalemba) Nlandu, Nkusu (Mpata) Tezzo, Makiese (Ntale) Lukama and Nadia (Nlandu Nkondi) Nlandu; and her brother, Alfred Dakwa (Mireille Kumbu) Nlandu. Florence pursued her B.S. and master's degrees in computer science at Northern Illinois University in DeKalb, where she also became part of the Peterson extended family. Funeral services will be held at 10:30 a.m. Saturday, Aug. 4, at The Chapel, 1200 American Way, Libertyville, Ill. Park Ave. (Route 176, one block west of Milwaukee Ave.), Libertyville, and from 8:30 a.m. until time of services at the church on Saturday. Interment will follow at Lakeside Cemetery. In lieu of flowers, memorials are being directed to the Mayengo Florence Nlandu Trust and will go to a scholarship fund she established some years ago for the education of street children in Kinshasa, the capital city of Congo.
