So of course I tried to do everything she did, like reading above my pay grade, reasonably successfully, and becoming a blonde-very unsuccessfully. So many stories to choose from, but the geese stand out. Some nights in the room we shared in Iowa as children she would say: "Listen!" And what we were listening to was the sound of the migrating geese overhead--flying in a great V, she explained, with the leader at the point. But I never saw them--until years later, I was driving back from a visit to our mother in Iowa when I saw them overhead one afternoon, spread across the sky in that great V Muriel told me about. Muriel was ill for a long time, cared for with care by her family. But I think on her journey to new life and reunion for a while she was part of that great V, flying with the wild geese across the wide sky.
