Nancy S. Regan, 71, passed away Monday, August 15, 2016 at her home with her family by her side. She was born May 11, 1945 in Eugene, OR where she grew up and had been living in Wauconda for the past thirty years. Nancy received a Masters Degree in Library Sciences from the University of Minnesota, Duluth. She was a former Fourteen year employee at Abbott Laboratories where she helped design the company's first online medical library. She retired as library operations manager at Hospira Inc., a subsidiary of Abbott Labs., where she was employed for ten years in the global library services department. Nancy was a very gifted musician and was an active member of the Barrington United Methodist Church where she sang in the church choir.

She is survived by her husband of five years Ian Swinton of Wauconda; two children, Ruth Regan of Littleton, CO, John Regan of Chicago; brother, Raymond (Bok Hui) Sifdol of Manhattan, KS; sister, Sally (Gary) Denzler of Portland, OR; and by her nephew, Ray Sifdol.

She was preceded in death by her husband Jack Regan in 2003.
