



Nedeljko Gojkovic

September 16, 1940 - October 27, 2023

Nedeljko Gojkovic, 83, passed away on Friday, October 27, 2023, in Lincolnshire, IL. He was born on September 16, 1940, in Bosnia and immigrated to the United States in December 1967. Nedeljko was a longtime resident of Waukegan and lived in Gurnee for the past 30 years.

Nedeljko was a veteran of the Yugoslavian Navy, enlisting at age 18, and served honorably throughout Europe for three years. He is a former employee of Highland Park-based Solo Cup Corporation where he was employed for 40 years. Nedeljko was also a member of St. Nikolas Serbian Orthodox Church in Waukegan, and later a member of St. Basil of Ostrog Serbian Orthodox Church in Lake Forest when the congregations merged.

Surviving is his wife, Melana Gojkovic; two children, Dan (Rachael) Austen and Diane (Michael) Botello; five grandchildren, Chase, Kate, Blake, Morgan and Kira, and by a brother, Zdravko Gojkovic.

Nedeljko was preceded in death by his parents Simeun and Jovanka Gojkovic, by his brother Vlado, and by his sisters Desanka, Dusanka and Vinka.
