



## Paul E. Brady Jr.

Paul E. Brady, Jr., 90, passed away on Friday, July 1, 2022 in Lincolnshire, IL. Born the son of Paul and Catherine (Horan) Brady of Lake Forest, IL. He was a graduate of both Lake Forest High School and Lake Forest College. Upon his graduation in 1953, Paul joined the United States Air Force serving as a pilot and captain until his Honorable Discharge from the USAFR in 1970. Captain Brady enjoyed flying the remainder of his life staying actively involved as a pilot and an avid member of the aviation community.

Paul retired from a successful 37-year career in business, finance, and consulting in 1995, but for those seeking and navigating their own business careers his guidance, and support never ended.
