Robert S. "Bob" Quandt, 91, passed away on Wednesday, Oct. 15, 2014 at Advocate Condell Medical Center in Libertyville. He was born Dec. 10, 1922 in Wethersfield, CT, was formerly of Lincolnshire and has lived in Libertyville for the past 38 years. He was a US Army Air Corps veteran, having served in Italy during WWII and a graduate of Mt. Herman College in Massachusetts. Bob and Jean would raise and show Newfoundland Dogs, were members of the Newfoundland Club of America and attended Faith Church in Grayslake.
