Rolland S. Carlson, 79, passed away on Friday, Feb. 24, 2012, at Advocate Condell Medical Center. He was born April 15, 1932 in Chicago, and was a former resident of Mount Prospect, living in Libertyville since 1988. He was an army veteran, having served in Germany and a graduate of Augustana College in Rock Island. He received his Masters in Business Administration from the University of Chicago and was a retired executive from the Harris Bank in Chicago. He was a member of the Libertyville Covenant Church, and following his retirement was an active volunteer and later president of the Covenant Ministries of Benevolence.
