Ronald A. Ellwing, 90, passed away peacefully on Sunday, April 10, 2016 at his home in Libertyville, IL. He was born December 3, 1925 in Chicago, IL and had been a Libertyville resident since 1970. Ron was formerly employed at International Minerals & Chemicals Corporation for 43 years, was a charter member of Hope Evangelical Presbyterian Church in Grayslake and served as an elder.
