Our only son and brother, Scott Terence Bohl, 26, passed away at his apartment in Chicago on April 6th, 2017. He was born June 6th, 1990 and was a 2008 graduate of Libertyville High School. Scott was a proud Cyclone and received his B.S. degree in Apparel Merchandising and Design from Iowa State University. He previously was employed by Men's Wearhouse and was a Soft Lines Team Leader at Target in Chicago.

Scott had a captivating smile, infectious laugh and tender heart. A creative soul, he was known for his signature style along with trendy haircuts and, most of all, SHOES!
