



## Sharon J. Holy

March 14, 1945 - February 11, 2025

Sharon Jane Holy (Dalton), 79, passed away on February 11, 2025. She was born March 14, 1945 in Cape Girardeau, MO. Originally from Jackson, Missouri, her parents were Mr. & Mrs. Maple (Mabel) Dalton which preceded her in death. As a 1963 graduate of Jackson High School, Sharon went on to graduate from Barnes School of Nursing in St. Louis in 1967.
