“ David Ford: There are so many many great Mom memories. One of the great ones happened during wintertime when we were living in Salt Lake City. I was in fourth grade at Oakridge Elementary School. It was late morning, and I wasn't feeling well. My teacher, Mrs. Smith, took me back to the nurses office to have my temperature taken. It was 102. Meanwhile, it was snowing heavily.
