Sigmund R. Spilis formerly of Mundelein Sigmund R. Spills, 97, a resident of Crystal Lake for the past three years, passed away on Tuesday, March 6, 2012, at the Springs of Crystal Lake. He was born Sept. 10, 1914, in Chicago, and was a Chicagoland area resident for most of his life. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army Air Corps and served during World War II as a navigator on a B-29.
