Stephanie H. Greene, 64, passed away from an accidental fall from a ladder while landscaping at her home in Kildeer on Thursday, Aug. 21, 2014. She was born June 20, 1950 in Lake Forest, IL and was a Libertyville resident for most of her life. She was a graduate of Ferry Hall in Lake Forest, received her degree in journalism and history at Syracuse University and her MBA from Cornell University in Ithaca, NY. She was the co-owner of a real estate investment and an educational publishing firm, was active with the Winnetka Community Theatre and enjoyed traveling. A large part of Stephanie's life were her gardens. She was a past president of the Town and County Garden Club of Libertyville and a past president of the Garden Clubs of Illinois. She was a National Garden Club accredited master judge and National Garden Club and CR board member. Surviving are her brothers, Chris (Vicky) Greene of Libertyville and Geoff (Jan) Greene of Mundelein; Nieces, Melissa and Beth Greene and Nephews, Trevor (Tiffany) Greene and Derek Greene; Great Nephews, Xavier and Kaleb.
