Suk Cha Parello, age 83, of Lake Forest, peacefully passed away Wednesday, August 7, 2024, at her home with her family. She was born in South Korea on May 8, 1941, to Ki Yong Yi and Pan Im Shon. Suk Cha was the sixth child of eight brother and sisters, Duk Sul Yi, Chong Go Yi, Jum Yi, Soe Yi, Chong Soo Yi, Chong Mo Yi, and Seung Yi.

Suk Cha met the love of her life, James Parello, a dashing young Army soldier protecting Korea. In 1962 she immigrated from Korea to the United States with her new husband, excited about starting her own family.
