Tim G. Steiner had a big bellowing laugh, a unique and hilarious sense of humor, a tremendous love of music and could sing "Thunder Road" at the top of his lungs when called upon. He was brilliant, sweet, and beloved by many. We are shocked that he is gone so soon; 48 years is much too short a time with such an amazing man. Tim passed away unexpectedly Tuesday, Feb. 2, 2016 at his home in Chicago. He was born Oct. 15, 1967 in Winfield, IL, to Thomas and Betty Steiner. Tim was raised in Libertyville and was a 1985 graduate of Libertyville High School, where he was fortunate to find lifelong friends. He received a Masters degree from the University of Illinois and lived in Chicago for more than 20 years, where he met and married his wife of 15 years. Tim loved his career in Human resources and was energized by the people he worked with.
