William E. "Bill" Betke, 92, passed away at his home at Spring Meadows in Libertyville on Mon. June 22, 2020. He was born Feb. 9, 1928 in Evanston, IL, where he was a 1946 graduate of Evanston High School and received his BS from Northwestern University. He was also a former resident of Green Oaks and Saddlebrook Farms in Grayslake. Bill was a US Army veteran, having served in Okinawa during WWII and later Korea and a member of the United Methodist Church in Libertyville. He was a past master of the Evanston Masonic Lodge, life member of the Medinah Shrine, Shepherds of the Liberty Shrine and Order of the White Shrine of Jerusalem in Libertyville. He was a former Vice President of accounting at the Consumer Credit Union in Waukegan and enjoyed spending winters in Estero, Florida.
